1. Border	4-Border is evident and used the correct size.			1-Border is evident but used the wrong size.	0-Incomplete or not demonstrated.
2. No Visible Gridlines	4-Grid is completely erased in all areas. No visible signs of a grid.	3-Grid is erased in all areas. Grid is slightly visible and takes a while to notice.	2-Attempt to erase grid is evident in most areas. Grid still visible in a couple areas.	1-Attempt to erase grid in a couple areas is evident.	0-Incomplete. No or little value shown and no attempt to erase gridlines.
3. No Outlines Visible	4-No outlines are visible. All evidence of the use of outlines are hidden.	3-Attempt to hide outlines. Very few outlines are visible. May take a while to notice.	2-Attempt to hide outlines. Outlines are visible in 25%-50% of the piece.	1-Attempt to hide some of the outlines. Outlines are visible in over 50% of the piece.	0-Incomplete. Outlines visible throughout the piece. No attempt to hide outlines. May be like a coloring book.

Value	4-Evidence of Black, White and more than three middle values.	3- Evidence of Black, White and three middle values.	2- Evidence of Black, White and/or two or less middle values.	1-Evidence of Black or white is missing and/or only one middle value.	0-Incomplete. Black and white missing or only two values are evident.
5. Craftsmanship of Paper	4- Paper is clean. No visible blemishes.	3- Paper is clean. Very minor dings are visible.	2- Paper has a couple dings or minor folds and wrinkles are visible.	1-Paper has many dings and/or folds. Paper is folded in half.	0-Paper is torn or ripped and/or has many folds.
