DRAWING FENCE POSTS IN PERSPECTIVE OCCASIONALLY YOU MAY WANT TO DRAW OBJECTS WITH EQUAL SPACING SUCH AS FENCEPOSTS, TELEPHONE POLES, LINES IN SIDEWALKS, OR, STRIPES DOWN A HIGHWAY IN PERSPECTIVE. HERE'S HOW, A STEP AT A TIME ... VANISHING POINT HORIZON LINE (1) begin with a horizon 2 NEXT, DRAW LINE, A VANISHING POINT RECEDING LINES AND YOUR FROM YOUR FIRST POST FIRST POST. TO THE VANISHING POINT. DRAW A SECOND DRAW AN POST (WHEREVER YOU "X" BETWEEN THINK IT LOOKS RIGHT) BETWEEN THE RECEDING THE TWO POSTS. LINES. DRAW A LINE FROM THE CENTER OF THE "X" TO THE VANISHING POINT. START AT THE BOTTOM OF THE DRAW A DIAGONAL LINE THROUGH THE CENTER OF THE SECOND POST. NOTICE WHERE THE "CENTER LINE" CROSSES THE SECOND POST. STOP THIS DIAGONAL LINE AT THE TOP RECEDING LINE. (7)NOW, MOVE TO THE BOTTOM OF THE SECOND POST AND DRAW A DIAGONAL LINE THROUGH THE CENTER OF THE THIRD POST TO FIND THE PLACE WHERE THE DIAGONAL LINE TOUCHES THE TOP RECEDING LINE, DRAW A THIRD POST. TO DRAW THE FOURTH POST. (9) CONTINUE THE PATTERN UNTIL YOU HAVE ALL THE POSTS O GETTING SHORTER, YOUR POST SHOULD ALSO BE GETTING CLOSER TOGETHER. FINALLY, ERASE ALL OF YOUR GUIDELINES AND ADD TEXTURE AND SHADING TO YOUR DRAWING.
