

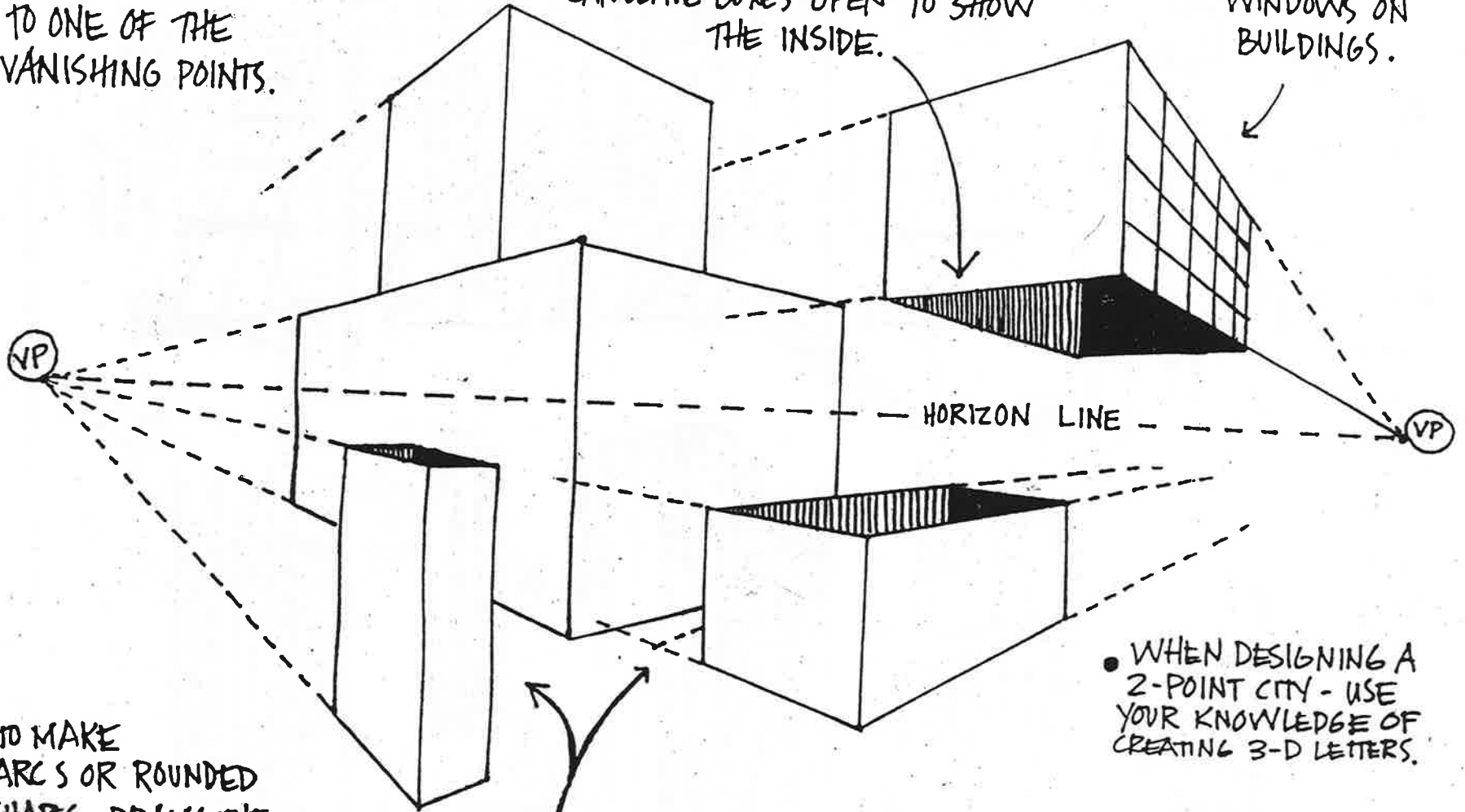
2-POINT PERSPECTIVE

A. COOK

- ALL LINES ARE VERTICAL OR GOING TO ONE OF THE VANISHING POINTS.

- BOXES ABOVE THE HORIZON LINE WILL SHOW THE BOTTOM + BOXES BELOW WILL SHOW THE TOPS. YOU CAN LEAVE BOXES "OPEN" TO SHOW THE INSIDE.

- USE PROPORTIONAL SPACING TO MAKE WINDOWS ON BUILDINGS.



- TO MAKE ARCS OR ROUNDED SHAPES - DRAW THE SQUARES FIRST + FIT SHAPES INTO SQUARES.

- WHEN DESIGNING A 2-POINT CITY - USE YOUR KNOWLEDGE OF CREATING 3-D LETTERS.

- THIS IS AN EASY WAY TO BUILD A CITY. JUST PILE BOXES ON TOP OF EACH OTHER. LEAVE SPACE BETWEEN THEM TO CREATE SIDEWALKS + STREETS.
