

Hallway Drawing Tutorial

1-Point Perspective


1. Create a rectangle in the middle of your paper. This represents the end of the hallway. The larger the rectangle the closer you are to the end of the hallway.




2. Create a *horizon line* toward the bottom of your rectangle. This represents your eye level if you were sitting on the floor in the hallway.




3. Place a *vanishing point* on the *horizon line* inside of the rectangle.




4. Draw the *receding lines* from the *vanishing point*, through the four corners of your rectangle, to the edge of your paper.




5. Now find at least three items to place in perspective. These items will be found along the walls, floor, or ceiling.




6. Draw the line closest to you from one of those objects. It will be a vertical line if seen on the wall and a horizontal line if seen on the floor or ceiling.




7. Draw the receding lines from each end of the line going back to the vanishing point.



8. Draw the back end of the object by inserting another line. Repeat steps 7-9 for each object.



9. Add and clean up any lines.



10. Finished hallway drawing.
